Grant Proposals are now being accepted for 2017

The Children's Cancer Foundation, Inc. (CCF) is accepting requests for its traditional Grant Proposals and for the Giant Food NextGen Award for Children's Cancer Research for 2017. Please share this Request For Proposals with investigators in your department as you think appropriate. CCF provides Grants in support of pediatric cancer research in the Maryland/DC/N.Va area.

CCF welcomes meritorious laboratory and clinical research proposals. Grants will be awarded for a period of one year, beginning November 2017. The total budget for grants is \$75,000. Applicants who have received a previous grant may apply for continued funding, but must include the results of their current research, discuss the progress made in prior year(s), and state how continued funding will advance research in this area. Providing publications citing CCF support is an ongoing requirement.

Details of the 2017 CCF Grant Submission Process:

Please be certain that the Cover Sheet is completed and that all current and requested Grants, particularly those addressing similar topics, are disclosed, and that the Department Chair signs the Cover Sheet.

All Grant Proposals must be received no later than 11:59 PM (EST) May 1, 2017.

Grant Proposals are reviewed by an independent review board. Funding is not allowed to overlap with other currently funded projects. Notification of Grant Awards will be made in August 2017, and formal agreements will follow. Award checks will be presented to recipients at the CCF Gala on November 4, 2017.

Requirements of grant awardees after notification:

1. Present a two (2) page report within 30 days of the grant termination. If a grant renewal is requested, then a one (1) page introduction describing progress should be included with the grant request.
2. Attend CCF Gala on November 4, 2017, The Valley Mansion by Martins Cockeysville, MD.
3. Recipient must attend following year CCF Research Symposium as a speaker
